Nicola is from Connahs Quay and has worked at the Brook Street store for the past 7 months, previously she worked at the store in Connahs Quay. Nine people work in the store and they are from a variety of places including Blacon, Newtown and Hoole in Chester and Pembrokeshire.

The shop gets a lot of passing trade because of the train station and being one of the main routes into town along with regular shoppers who live in the street.
